

The 9th Tourism Summits in Chamonix Mont-Blanc 12th, 13th and 14th December 2007

Property: from the boom to unbalance in tourist resorts

Victims of their own success, some tourist resorts are seeing an explosion in the value of holiday property in their towns and villages which translates into an imbalance between commercial letting, holiday homes and permanent lodgings.

For its ninth edition, the Tourism Summits are proposing an analysis of the current situation and eventual innovative solutions with experts from France and abroad, meeting in Chamonix Mont-Blanc on the 12th, 13th and 14th December 2007.

The ninth Tourism Summits in Chamonix-Mont-Blanc will broach these questions through:

- **Interventions** on the **principles**
- The presentation of **innovative cases**
- **Debates** around the different themes, chaired by experts.

Professor Peter Keller, President of the Scientific Committee of the Tourism Summits, along with numerous experts will assist the debates on subjects around the following themes:

- **The future needs in accommodation for both visitors and residents.**
- **The leisure property market: why buy and invest?**
- **The innovations in the leisure property market: how can we better use and market holiday apartments?**
- **The stagnant structures of accommodation: what can we do against these empty beds?**
- **Property policies for tourist communities: how can we rejuvenate tourist accommodation and the local habitation?**

- **The interests of the local populations: can we master the socio-economic effects of the strong demand for holiday property?**
- **The local measures to be taken to better manage the development in leisure activities: should the State intervene?**
